Findley “Read for Goats” – Winter Reading Challenge TEACHER FACT SHEET

A challenge to children to read during December and over Winter Break, while benefitting someone in need at the same time!

THE CHALLENGE: The “Read for Goats” challenge directly links the learning we do in classrooms about being empowered to make a difference in our world! Once again, Findley students and the PTO will partner with Mercy Corp and the Cedar Mill Library to help people in some of the poorest, most difficult parts of the world. For millions of impoverished people, livestock can offer a lifeline – but starting a herd is hard. Goats provide nutritious milk and meat, and bring in income that let's struggling families purchase the goods they need. Findley PTO pledged to sponsor a pair of goats for every 1,500 hours of reading the students complete. A donation will be made to Mercy Corps that can supply a pair of goats to a family in need to help them improve their lives. We hope to sponsor 6 families!
